Fleming is a founding member of the legendary Libre Artists' Commune, established in 1968 in the upper Huerfano Valley. The Libre Artist's Commune spans 360 acres at the base of the Greenhorn Mountains. Dean Fleming's dome house was the first structure built on this land, which is shared and governed by the commune's bylaws. 57 years later, Fleming continues to live and create in this unique space. This tour offers a rare glimpse into the history of this influential artistic community and the personal world of a pioneering artist.
